## Implementation Guidelines for English Graduation Requirements and Remedial Measures in the Department of Applied English at Kaohsiung University

December 25, 2013: Approved in the 8th Departmental Affairs Meeting of the 2014 academic year.

January 8, 2014: Approved in the 5th College Affairs Meeting of the 2014 academic year.

February 25, 2014: Verified in the 6th Academic Affairs Meeting of the 2014 academic year.

December 28, 2016: Amended and approved in the 9th Departmental Affairs Meeting of the 2016 academic year.

April 11, 2017: Amended and approved in the 5th Academic Affairs Meeting of the 2016 academic year.

April 21, 2021: Amended and approved in the 10th Departmental Affairs Meeting of the 2019 academic year.

November 24, 2021: Amended and approved in the 6th Departmental Affairs Meeting of the 2021 academic year.

- The Department of Applied English at Kaohsiung University (hereinafter referred to as the Department) formulates these guidelines to align with the English graduation requirements specified in students' course planning charts.
- 2. Undergraduate students enrolled in the Department from the academic year 110 onwards are required to fulfill the English graduation requirements outlined in the Department's undergraduate course planning chart. Those who do not meet the requirements must take and pass both 'Graduation English Proficiency Test (Upper)' and 'Graduation English Proficiency Test (Lower)' for a total of 4 credits. For students enrolled prior to the academic year 110, those who do not meet the requirements must take and pass the 'Graduation English Proficiency Test' for 2 credits. However, for new students enrolled from the academic year 106 onwards, these credits will not be included in the graduation credits.
- 3. Senior students in the undergraduate program of the Department (including deferred graduates) who have not passed the English graduation requirements specified in the Department's course planning chart (as listed below) are eligible to enroll in this course. They must also submit one copy of the official English proficiency test score report:
  - 1. GEPT Intermediate.
  - 2. TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) score of 650.
  - 3. IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score of 4.0. TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) IBT score of 47. Other English proficiency test types equivalent to the English graduation requirements of CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) Level B1 (Intermediate level), excluding points 1 to 4.
- 4. Graduate students in the Department must meet the English graduation requirements specified in the Department's master's program course planning chart. Those who do not meet the requirements may take relevant English proficiency courses for 2 credits as a substitute. However, for students enrolled from the academic year 106 onwards, these credits will not be included in the graduation credits.
- 5. Second-year master's students in the Department (including deferred graduates) who have not passed the English graduation requirements specified in the Department's course planning chart (as listed below) are eligible to enroll in relevant courses. They must also submit one copy of the official English proficiency test score report:
  - 1. GEPT High-Intermediate.
  - 2. TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) score of 750.

- 3. IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score of 5.5.
- 4. TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) IBT score of 71.
- 5. Other English proficiency test types equivalent to the English graduation requirements of CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) Level B2 (Advanced level), excluding points 1 to 4.
- 6. These guidelines have been approved in the Departmental Affairs Meeting and the College Affairs Meeting, and have been submitted to the Academic Affairs Meeting for verification. They are implemented after verification and are also subject to amendments through the same process.
