S.2.4 Before the last semester, students who didn't pass the english proficiency test(5.2.1.), must take a course relevant with English proficiency test (2 credits) from your department, The course is not included in the graduation credits. T.4 Before the last semester, students who didn't pass the english Japanese, and Chinese before or after (including) the 2021 academic year are recognized or credited by the courses offered after the 2022 academic year.
